

Reviewing What's Public on your Facebook Profile




If you're a regular Facebook user, you've probably shared more posts and pictures than you can count. It's easy to lose track of what info is public on your profile. While taking the time to review Facebook's privacy settings is very important, there's also an easy and quick way to see what on your Facebook account is visible to the public: the **View As** feature.

Using the View As Feature

You can access View As when using Facebook in a web browser or in the app, but the feature in the app is limited. We'll go over the web browser where you can use it to see what's publicly visible on your entire profile.

1 After you sign in to your Facebook account in a web browser, you'll see your Feed. Click your **profile picture** in the left side menu or the top, right corner to get your profile page.









Using the View As Feature, Cont'd

On your profile page, scroll down and click on the **three dots** above your posts. Then, select **View As** in the menu that opens.



Now you can see what people who are NOT friends with you on Facebook can see. Click **each section of your profile** (Posts, About, Friends, Photos, etc) to see what's public. In the image below, Janet learns that three of her photos are visible to anyone on Facebook.






Choosing your Audience


Once you've reviewed everything on your profile, click **Exit View As** at the top of the screen to return to using Facebook as you normally would.



If you noticed profile details, posts, pictures, reels, or anything else that you do not want to be public, click the **globe** to change the audience. Or you can edit or delete any items on your no longer want on your account.



You choose who sees what content on your Facebook profile. These are the most common audience choices.






Note that your profile and cover photos are always public.



Finding Privacy Settings

You should also regularly review the privacy settings of your account. Follow these steps to navigate to the privacy settings in the browser.

- 1 After you sign in to Facebook, click on your **profile picture** in the top, right corner of the screen.
- In the menu that opens, click Settings& privacy.
- Next, click Settings.





It's a good idea to review the options under "Audience and visibility" and "Your activity."
